This statement supports my application for BA (Hons) Business Management. In two of the institutions I am applying to the course links to marketing; an associated area I have an interest in.

The desire to study business management stems from my A level studies, where I am predicted top grades in Business Studies, Mathematics and Information Technology. The blending of these A levels were chosen from the start with a wider desire to take Business Management, as I come from a family where my father has run a small business and I have been increasingly involved with the day to day running of the business, looking at advertising, staffing and expenditure. I am very interested in ethics within business as environmental concerns are close to my heart, I want to be an ethical leader, someone that is aware of social issues and equal rights.

I have work experience based in the family business. We have a small family business that sells and rents small tools. There is a staff of three and the business was established by my father twenty years ago. During the Covid-19 Pandemic we adapted the business offering a change in business direction, as tools were still required for hire, even though we were unable to open the business fully. Through adaption of the business model we were able to continue via pre ordering of tools and delivery to local customers through direct delivery and drop off. It has shown me the importance of being open to alternatives and thinking around the box.

Outside of study, I enjoy sport. I find exercise helps me to focus academically as well, and at school I have played in the school football team as a midfielder. I would hope at University to join the University football team as I find it is a wonderful way to make friends and really divert yourself away from other pressures.
